### FROM THE PRESIDENT

Most alpaca breeders have heard of EPD's, but not all have had the time to read enough to really understand what they are and how they can help each and every alpaca breeder.

Many articles about EPD's are written in science language. Some alpaca breeders have not had that as their "foreign language." This article will explain EPD's in normal English language.

**EPD stands for Expected Progeny Differences.** It would be easier if we called them Best Odds For a Better Cria. Basic laws of genetics explain that each parent passes a random one-half of its genes to its offspring. Because only one-half of the genes are passed on, only one-half of the breeding value is passed to the progeny. The term used for one-half of the average breeding value is EPD. EPDs can be used as a tool to guide selective breeding decisions in ways that increase, decrease or maintain any trait value measured in subsequent generations. An EPD database really consists of two databases. One database contains all the animal's pedigrees. The pedigree database allows the animals in the database to be linked by genealogy (aunts, uncles, cousins, 10th cousins.) The 2<sup>nd</sup> database has the traits that were measured for each animal, (for example, average micron, CV, conformation, etc). The traits database can record numerous traits for each animal. Those databases grow each year as more animals and their traits are added. The more relationships present in the database for any given Suri, the more reliable are the EPDs that are generated.

When an EPD is "run," what happens is that those two databases are analyzed through a computer program that does complex calculations. This process results in a number for each trait that represents the expectation of that Suri's ability to influence a measured trait in his offspring. These numbers are summarized and published as a "sire summary." The published numbers can then be used to compare Suri herdsires directly on the basis of their EPD values. An EPD is a

measure of the degree of difference between the progeny of a particular Suri herdsire and the average of Suri herdsires in the database. The data from a sire summary can be used to select herdsires that are superior for traits that are desired and inferior for those traits that are undesirable.

An EPD is usually given as a plus or minus value. Think of it like this: if the average man in the U.S. (the U.S. human herd) is 5'10" and there is a man who is 5'11" and this 5'11" man has 12 children that average 6'2", then this man's EPD for height would be +3". This is a simplified example, the statistical calculations for a real EPD are much more complex. We would also know that this individual man is 1" taller than the average male human. So we need the height measurement of many, many men to tell us the average male human's height in the U.S. before we could actually calculate this EPD. That is why the more men measured for height the more accurate that average number will be. So, for Suris, the more Suris included in the database, the more accurate our average numbers and EPD's will be. As the database grows each year, and we see our averages change, we will also see that we are making progress overall in the Suris in the U.S.

We can easily see some of the best examples of how much EPDs have helped improve certain traits by looking at other livestock industries. Using EPD's, cattle breeders have been able to greatly improve certain desired traits, such a meat marbling. They chose to use sires whose offspring/progeny have more marbling than the average animal in their database.

If I have a female that is a great dam with lots of milk, her cria have great conformation, good locks, good luster, but are not real great on the micron, I probably want to breed her to a male that is more likely to improve (decrease) that average micron number. What is the best way to select that male? I can look around for a male with finer micron, and I can even look at some of his offspring; however, as we all know, some males have great micron

but they don't pass that on to their cria. Is there a better way? What if I could look at a database of breeding males, and this database could tell me not just the male's average micron, but tell me which males are more likely to produce a cria with lower micron? An EPD will tell me whether or not he typically passes that finer micron to his offspring. Next I can look for what other traits this male is strong or weak on to see if those make sense for this female as well. Who knows, Mr. Right may be in my own herd or right down the road at my neighbor's farm, saving money on transportation. The numbers make this process of sire selection so much easier and objective.

The chart below is an abbreviated example of what an EPD chart might look like. I can see that males 1, 2 and 4 tend to decrease the fiber diameter/micron in their offspring compared to the average population in the database. I can also tell that male #2 produces the biggest decrease in his offspring (progeny) with a -3.5.

Male ID #	Fleece Weight	Fiber Diameter	Fiber Length
1	+2.11	-2.5	+5
2	+2.7	-3.5	-5
3	+3.5	+1.0	+1
4	+2.9	-1.8	+8

Now, if I was looking for a male whose offspring produced more fiber length per year, then I would want to look for positive numbers, not negative. Thus some traits I want a positive number and some traits I want to see a negative number.

EPDs cannot guarantee but they can predict outcomes. However, significant differences in management, will affect the expression of genetic traits to a variable degree. For example, alpacas sired by a male with a lower EPD for weaning weight could sire higher weaning weight crias than those sired by a male with a lower weaning weight EPD if they are exposed to a more favorable environment (fed 2<sup>nd</sup> cut hay vs. 1<sup>st</sup> cut, or more supplements in a creep feeder). The resulting

weaning weights in this example are, to a large degree, determined by environment and not genetics. As more and more Suris enter the database from more and more farms, the effects of individual environments and management practices will level out. This is because EPD calculations adjust for different environments by a statistical process referred to in EPD calculations as 'related groups'. These related groups take into account varying environments so that the predicted difference is valid under any environment.

EPDs are not constant. As more information is obtained on an animal's offspring, the EPD may change, particularly as more progeny information is recorded. This does not mean that the alpaca's genetic make-up changes as he ages, but that the ability to predict the alpaca's EPDs is improved as more information becomes available. Therefore, it is impossible to predict whether an animal's EPDs will go up or down.

Yes! Expected Progeny Differences are a highly accurate means of predicting the transmitting ability of certain genetic traits of animals as parents. Expected Progeny Differences (EPDs) allow the prediction of *DIFFERENCES*, not the trait measurement.

Suri Network will continue to publish articles on how to understand the details of the values, numbers and heritability concepts of EPDs as the SN EPD program unfolds.

It really is not difficult to understand the concepts and use them to our benefit. Geneticists speak "Geneticease," but once translated into normal English, you can see how exciting this is as a tool to advance all of our Suris' desired traits. The worldwide livestock organizations utilize EPD's as standard practice, with proven results, so shall we!

I would like to thank Dick Walker for his insightful comments and suggestions.

## AFFILIATES, ALPACA EVENT COORDINATORS AND ALPACA ENTHUSIASTS

As a growth industry, it is important that we continue to promote the wonderful aspects of alpacas. Whether your niche is breeding colored animals, show ring success or alpaca fiber, the ongoing promotion of our industry is paramount to our success. In 2009, the Suri Network created the IPHAY program. IPHAY is the fund raising vehicle of the Suri Network which is solely dedicated to the promotion of Suri alpacas through advertising media. Our current partner is USA Today. Our first effort to raise money resulted in member contributions of \$14,000. The Suri network more than matched this amount and 100% of this total was spent on an advertising campaign using USA Today, focused on building awareness of the Suri alpaca. In the spring of this year, we ran two ads covering the national circulation of more than 3 million readers. After the ads ran, hits on The Suri Network website increased substantially. As everyone knows advertising is a form of communication intended to persuade an individual or group to take some form of action. Results are not achieved over night and any

awareness campaign should be ongoing to achieve effective results.

It is the opinion of the Suri Network that historically alpaca breeders have promoted alpacas to each other. We spend a lot of time, effort and money making other alpaca breeders aware of upcoming events. As a group we have not been very good at promoting alpaca events to the outside world. Intuitively we are all aware of the alluring characteristics of the alpaca. The reasons that attracted all of us to the alpaca industry are alive and well today. Thousands of individuals across the country would love to learn more about these magnificent animals if only made aware or given the opportunity. The Suri Network is committed to our advertising program and would like to expand our effort by offering insight, monetary support and our relationship with USA Today to AOBA affiliates, alpaca event coordinators and other alpaca enthusiasts.

The concept is to co-op an advertising effort, using USA Today, with an AOBA affiliate in conjunction with an alpaca show

or other type of alpaca event. USA Today has 25 print markets and the newspaper can be very specific regarding geographical areas in an effort to target market. The Suri Network has developed standard ads. We will also work with the affiliate to modify text, photos, etc. if they would like to make edits. Ad costs are between \$1,500 and \$3,500 for each region. Prices are driven by circulation numbers. The Suri Network will split the costs with the affiliate. We will do all the design work, paper work and handle all details with USA Today including invoice payment. All the affiliate has to do is pay their share of the USA Today invoice to the Suri Network.

If you or anyone you know is involved with the coordination of the many alpaca events held across the country please consider or pass along our offer. Just think, wouldn't it be great to see twice as many people at your next Alpaca show....and have the increase be new people who heard about the event from seeing it advertised in their local USA Today.

The first 101 suri fiber samples were mostly white or light colored. To complete the study, we needed dark colored suri fiber samples. The Suri Network helped to provide us with the additional one hundred and five (105) samples, 102 colored suri fiber, from the summer 2009 collection thru January, 2010.

SAMBA equipment was leased for a second month (January, 2010) to measure these colored samples.

Sample selection (multiple samples selected for the following):

1. Subjective assessment by judges
2. Matching samples tested for luster and color
3. Duplicate samples for testing on SAMBA (Bossa Nova Technologies)
4. Samples for NIR (Infrared)

Dry card samples to remove dirt and vegetable matter before straightening fibers in parallel configuration.

Load samples on individual fiber holders to aqueous wash and rinse duplicate samples.

Remove samples from individual fiber holders and hand rinse the clamped area of fiber sample.

Place samples on covered drying tray to air dry.

Condition for twenty four (24) hours at Standard Conditions (20°C, 65% RH) on covered drying tray.

(Conditioning takes longer from fiber samples that are not bone dry).

Card the samples a second time to further straighten and place fibers in parallel configuration.

Stretch fiber samples and attach to two inch by eight inch black paper using staples and strapping tape.

Attach samples to sample holder on the SAMBA Hair System for luster testing.

Send results to Nick Lechocinski of Bossa Nova Tech for his appraisal of the Suri luster data.

Additional tests have been run on these Suri alpaca samples: Lab scoured yields calculated for each sample, clean conditioned samples were measured for fiber diameter (MFD, SD, CV), fiber curvature (AC, CSD), and staple length (MSL, SDL, CVL).

Dr. Christopher Lupton presented an update to the Suri Network Symposium in Estes Park, Colorado on August 20, 2010. His presentation included subjective analysis by two certified AOBA fleece judges, Jude Anderson and Amanda VandenBosch.

The NIRS (Near Infrared System) analysis on the additional 105 samples tested in January, 2010, was not available at the meeting on August 20, 2010, but has since been completed.

Yet to be completed is preparation of final report and technical article, publication of refereed journal article to appear in the Small Ruminant Research Journal, and a "popular" version for suri alpaca industry magazine publication.

Yocom-McColl and Dr. Lupton will design individual animal reports for distribution of Suri Luster Study results to project participants. These individual reports will briefly explain luster and color (luminance) results.
