

# SURI NETWORK ALL SURI FLEECE SHOW BREEDER CUP AWARDS

The Suri Network will award three Breeder Cups in the All Suri Fleece Show Regular Fleece Competition:

**Emerald**- Small Entry, **Sapphire** - Medium Entry and **Diamond** - Large Entry. The divisions will be determined by the Show Superintendent based on the total number of entries after the close of registration. Winners will be announced soon after the show when the results have been tabulated. From year to year, the size of the divisions may change based on the number of entries in that show.

Points are awarded to Entrants for each entry based on their entry's placement in its class. The total points accrued by an Entrant are then divided by their entry total. The Show Superintendent will be responsible for the calculations.

## The Breeder Cup Divisions Are:

### EMERALD BREEDER CUP — SMALL ENTRY DIVISION

### SAPPHIRE BREEDER CUP — MEDIUM ENTRY DIVISION

### DIAMOND BREEDER CUP — LARGE ENTRY DIVISION

All Entrants with one or more entries are eligible and will automatically be placed into one of the above divisions. The number and assignment of Entrants into the divisions will be determined by the Show Superintendent after the close of registration. The Entrants with the highest number of points in each division will win the cups.

## The Following Fleece Show Entries Are Eligible:

- Regular Fleece Class Entry
- Get of Sire Class Entry (the Sire is a single entry)
- Produce of Dam Class Entry (the Dam is a single entry)

## Points Assigned to Placements in Fleece Show:

- First Place = 6 points
- Second Place = 5 points
- Third Place = 4 points
- Fourth Place = 3 points
- Fifth Place = 2 points
- Sixth Place = 1 points
- Color Champion = additional 7 points
- Reserve Color Champion = additional 5 points
- Judge's Choice = additional 10 points
- Specialty fleece awards = additional 5 points

# BREAKING TIES

## TIE BREAKER 1

The Show Superintendent will break the tie based on the number of entries for each Entrant. The Entrant that acquired the highest number of points with the fewest entries will win the tie.

### Example:

Entrant A ended the show with 25 points and a total entry count of 6  
Entrant B ended the show with 25 points and a total entry count of 4  
Entrant B will be declared the winner.

## TIE BREAKER 2

If a tie still exist after using Tie Breaker 1, the Show Superintendent will review all winnings of the Entrants in question and the ranch with the most first place awards will win the tie.

### Example:

Entrant A ended the show with four 1st place ribbons  
Entrant B ended the show with three 1st place ribbons  
Entrant A will be declared the winner.

## TIE BREAKER 3

If a tie still exists after using Tie Breakers 1 and 2, the Show Superintendent will assign multipliers to the 1st place entries of the tied Entrants. The multipliers will be based on the size of the classes that the 1st place awards were given.

### Example:

#### CLASS SIZE MULTIPLIER

1	1.1
2	1.2
3	1.3
4	1.4
5	1.5
6	1.6

Each first place ribbon awarded to the Entrants will be reassigned the new point value with the multiplier, and the Entrant awards will be re-calculated using the new values to determine the winners.
